Grapples for Forklifts - Grapples work together with the crowning operation of the bucket cylinder positioned on the excavator. They can mount directly onto the jib or whichever quick hitch that is in bucket position. Grapples are normally meant for the handling and processing of timber, construction materials, domestic and aggregate waste items. The grapple's boxed design has added support bridging. This manufactured design provides the grapple with maximum strength and support by means of preventing the body from breaking and twisting all through its function.

All of the moving parts which encompass the grapple, together with the toes, are made out of hardened steel. The pivot points have been particularly designed in order to guarantee supreme closing force and holding ability. The individual operating it has the capacity to handle all sizes and varieties of materials using the jaws fitted at the end of the grapple with toes. This can enable the jaws to be able to close through one another in a finger configuration for maximum handling capacity.
